BERSAY has advised Adevinta Ventures in its investment in the insurtech Lovys' Series A follow-on funding round, previously completed in January 2021. Lovys is taking advantage of this investment to launch its activity in Spain and Portugal and accelerate the development of its car insurance.

Adevinta Ventures is the investment arm of Adevinta, a global specialist in online classifieds that operates leading digital marketplaces in 16 countries. This transaction is the first investment made in France by Adevinta Ventures in the fintech and insurtech sector.

Lovys is the first 100% digital neo-insurance company that offers tailor-made products meeting the needs of new generations to support them at every stage of their lives. Lovys wants to offer the younger generations a complete protection, available on a single interface, entirely online.

This new investment, also made by the international insurance group MS&AD, makes Lovys Series A one of the largest in the BtoC insurtech sector in Europe. In addition, the startup announced the launch of its activity in Spain and Portugal with the support of Adevinta Ventures, which has already supported several startups in their European expansion.
